Suggested Ideas and Activities

- Make a T- Chart : Things I like / Things I do not like

- Complete a bar graph to find out what the class likes best
- Demonstrate physical things they like to do in the gym
- Make a collage of things they like
- Write or illustrate things students like about themselves
- Make a class list of things they like about themselves
- Discuss positive qualities in themselves and others (good for character education)
- Use a pocket chart to complete sentence "I like my -----"
- Make a class book of "Things we like "
