Suggested Ideas and Activities:

- Discuss and list the different activities they enjoy
- Compare and contrast winter and summer activities
- Dramatize a winter activity or sport they can do
- Graph their favourite season
- Discuss winter weather and how to stay healthy and safe
- Write and illustrate a class book on "Winter Fun"
- Complete individual 'I can' booklets for winter
- Create a class riddle book on winter fun
- Introduce/reviewing endings and locate them in the text
- Enjoy other books on winter
